

## Substance Abuse Affects us All....



- 83% of all crime is related to drug or alcohol abuse
- 57.8% of legally underage full time college students used alcohol; 40.1% engaged in binge drinking in a single month
- Bell Co Adult Population: 196,071: 8% are alcoholic
- Adult Population by 2015: 258,813
- 11.5% of adult population are addicted to drugs or alcohol (Bell Co. total: 22,548) (SAMSHA)\*
- Every substance abuser seriously affects at least 4 other persons, meaning 90,192 were affected in Bell County.
- Treatment is essential where persistent family cycles of addiction exist

"Breaking the bonds" is the battle cry for this year's campaign. That says it all. This statement outlines the nature of the warfare that takes place at CFTH. Chemical dependencies often develop as a coping mechanism for dealing with extreme dysfunction. Many have either misunderstood the message of God's love or never fully received it. In the end, addiction not only renders a person incapable of loving others, it also destroys a person's natural desire to care about his or her own life.

The Bible, the 12 steps of Recovery, and the *Search for Significance* all speak to the fact that God is love. Accepting God from this perspective changes a person's outlook. The love of God expressed through Jesus Christ makes the difference in faith-based recovery. Studies by the RAND Corp found that faith-based treatment is 15 times more effective in reducing crime than incarceration and the Bell County Probation Department confirmed a 73 percent success rate for for our clients from Bell County.

Numerous studies confirm these results for long term, faith-based treatment.
